

INTEGRATED DISEASE SURVEILLANCE PROGRAMME 2014-15




Background

The Integrated Disease Surveillance Project is a decentralized, State based surveillance programme of the country. IDSP was established to detect early warning signals of impending outbreak and initiate an effective and timely response. Also to provide essential data to monitor progress of ongoing disease control programme and help allocate health resources more efficiently.

The IDSP in Nagaland was initiated in the year 2004, and implemented in the later part of 2005 with the formation of State Surveillance Unit (SSU) and 11 District Surveillance Unit(DSU)

The support staffs under IDSP at the State Surveillance Unit (SSU) and the District Surveillance Unit (DSU) have been constituted and are in place.
