AMBULANCES / EMERGENCY REFERRAL TRANSPORT:

EMRI service is not available in the state due to resources constraints and poor road connectivity. Therefore, the state has opted only for Referral Transport through ambulance.

Achievement:

- a. Total No of Ambulance: 76
- b. GPS fitted in all ambulances and 1 mobile hand set (double SIM) provided to all the ambulances.
- c. Centralised Call Centre for Referral Transport set up by incorporating to the Health Helpline.
- d. A web based software (nagahmis) was developed with server domain (www: nagahmis.com) and Toll Free 102 telephone line for the Health Helpline to network all emergency services and to track and monitor the ambulances.
- e. All health units with ambulance are maintaining Performance Registers and Referral Cards. Majority of the health units are reporting the Ambulance Performance monthly. However, many units are not consistently reflecting the same in the HMIS.
