Family Planning

Objectives:

Unmet need for contraceptives is about 26.03% in the state and the unmet need for spacing is higher compared to that of limiting. It is proposed to reduce this unmet need for contraceptives to 20% by 2011-12.

Illustrative Activities:

- a. Access to non-clinical contraceptives increased in all villages in the state through community based distribution system and distribution by ASHAs in the villages.
- b. Promote accessibility to FP service facility at level
 - Promotion of 10 year IUD as an alternative to sterilization.
 - Accredition of Private Institutions:
 - Promotion of NSV and male responsibility in family planning in the state.



- Increasing sterilization camps for female and NSV camps in difficult areas.
- c. Skill upgardation of HWs:
 - Equipping the ANMs with skills to provide IUD services.
 - Increasing the access for sterilization methods by training MOs in Minilap and
 Female sterilization during Population Stabilization
- d. To generate demands and service availability through IEC/BCC/IPC information dessimination.
