- General health screening
- Assessment of nutritional status including anemia
- Visual acuity, hearing defects, dental problems
- Common skin problem
- Learning disorder, behavioural problems
- Adolescent reproductive health problems.
- To deliver various relevant health educational talks

School Health Programme covers the Government School students across the State for screening and referral. The School Health Team could screen 33050 students till date 2012 covering 1500 schools.
